## AMP MUSICIAN EXPECTATIONS



By being involved with this program, you will be treated as a professional musician/performer. You are expected to carry yourself and treat all other musicians, performers, coaches and staff as professionals.

- Your band can't rock without you plan on being at AMP from 10am-5pm every day of camp.
- Expect to be challenged.
- Being on time is considered being late—5 minutes early is considered on time. Morning rehearsal starts at 10 a.m.
- Be conscious and courteous of your band mates.
- Come prepared for camp on day 1, and take responsibility for your belongings, including gear, notes and music.
- Be prepared to engage with others and with different music styles that you may not like—the more people you are able to play music with, the more successful you will be.
- Be prepared to perform. Everyone is expected to sing with their band.
- Lead by example and communicate your expectations.
- There will be some work outside of the camp. Do your homework.
- If you don't understand something, ask specific questions.
- Write, improvise and be creative. Keep a songbook.
- Come up with your own goals and definition of success.
- Share your ideas and reflect on your experiences.
